will rest in the shadow of the Almighty.^[a]

² I will say of the Lord, 'He is my refuge and my fortress,

my God, in whom I trust.'

³ Surely he will save you

from the fowler's snare

and from the deadly pestilence.

⁴ He will cover you with his feathers,

Psalm chapter 91:1-16

THE ASSURANCE OF GOD'S

PROTECTION

1. The key to God's protection in Psalm 91 is to rest in Jesus finished work. (Mark Chapter 4: 35-40).

2. This Psalm of confidence reminds us that God protects and preserve those who are his Children

3. Live by the Word of God and experience his protection for our lives.

4. Finally, today your lives are covered by the wonderful promises of God's love (verses: 14-16)

How do you behave when trouble hits your life? Do you go to pieces? Look at Mark chapter 4: vs 35-49

How do you see faith and protection in these verses compare to Psalm 91 ?

The keys to our protection

Read verses 1-2

Dwells.....shadow,..... Abide.....Almighty

a) God is telling us that we dwell in safety when we sit down (rest)

Declaration of God's care and Protection

We will not fear - (vs 5-8) when disaster comes in many forms, yet those who trust

In him can live without fear.

We will not fail -(7-8) One thing that is emphasized throughout this Psalm is the promises of God's safety and protection

b) "We "Abide under the Shadow of the Almighty"

knowing comfort, protection and care (see John 15:4, psalm 27:5.

God's Promises, Safety and Protection for each one of us today (14-16)

In this final session we hear the voice of God as he reiterates the promises and blessings of the psalm

In 8 different ways in protecting his people

I will rescue you
I will protect him
I will answer him
I will be with him
I will be with him in trouble
I will deliver him
I will honour him
With long life will I satisfy him
I will show him my salvation
