Find this passage in your Bible:

Isaiah 55 v 8-11

Isaiah is in the Old Testament, find the big number 55 and the small number 8.

Take a moment to pause and pray asking God to help you learn and grow as you read the passage.

If there is a word you don't understand look it up, try to work it out from the words around it or ask somebody for help!

Isaiah was a prophet, somebody who heard from God and shared those messages with others.

In our story this week God had spoken to the Pharaoh through a dream but He used Joseph to help explain it to Pharaoh.

Challenge

Spend some time waiting on God and listening for His voice. Remember that God can speak to us in many different ways through words, pictures or feelings.



In your Bible find **1 Corinthians 14 v 3**, it is in the New Testament. This verse tells us why God gives prophecies through people.

Who is somebody famous you would like to meet?

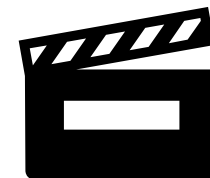
A question for children to ask adults
